1. WHAT IS MUNDUS 17

The “Mundus17” project is a consortium of European, Brazilian, Paraguayan and Uruguayan institutions in the area of higher education. This project is financed by the European Commission through the “Erasmus Mundus Programme (Action 2)”, which is one of EU’s cooperation programmes with third countries.

The main objectives of these initiatives are:

- To promote mobility of students, academic staff and researchers from Europe to Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay enabling valuable experiences at a linguistic, cultural and educational level;
- To enhance the international cooperation capacity between Higher Education Institutions in Europe, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay;
- To improve the transparency and recognition of studies and qualifications at international level;

The Mundus 17 is aimed at European undergraduate and doctorate students, post-doctorate researchers and academic staff willing to undertake a mobility period at the partner institutions in Brazil, Paraguay or Uruguay.

In addition to the scholarship, the Mundus 17 project also covers: travel costs to the selected country and insurance costs (travel, health, accidents). The programme foresees a fee waiver policy for exchanges up to 10 months.

3. WHO CAN APPLY

To be eligible for a mobility programme, applicants should meet the following requirements:

- Have nationality of one of the European countries;
- Good proficiency of the foreign language on the host institution (Portuguese and Spanish);
- In case of post-doctorate mobility, have been awarded the doctorate in the last two years and have the support of one European institution partner in the consortium;
- Undergraduate students must have successfully completed at least one year of studies in their home institution;
- Must be enrolled in one of the following European Higher Education Institutions:
